how and why does one become a neurosurgeon dr anthony chiurco delineates a life in medicine that moves from childhood on the rough streets of south philadelphia to success in a career that is as stressful as it is profoundly rewarding he discusses his early programming by the catholic church and the eventual dismissal of organized religion and his path to atheism how life on earth originated is discussed broadly as well as on the molecular level with a friendly explanation for the reader uneducated in the biological sciences whether discussing life in an italian american family or evaluating current topics such as medical malpractice insurance companies or government policy he presents his opinions candidly and without apology his experiences and preoccupation with sailing and the sport of rowing are discussed with earned pride and affection both a celebration and

from mayors and mummers to tap dancers and gamblers south philly has it all this quintessential philadelphia neighborhood boasts a complicated history of ethnic strife alongside community solidarity and for good measure some of the best bakeries in town among its many famous people south philadelphia claims marian anderson frankie avalon mayor frank rizzo temple owl s coach john chaney larry fine of the three stooges and loving soap opera actress lisa peluso for south philadelphians whether they stay or leave the neighborhood is always happy to give you their opinions and in this book they talk about their favorite subject to murray dubin award winning journalist at the philadelphia inquirer who also called south philly home music and the arts are part of everyday life baritone elliot tessler says i m not a celebrity i m a minor curiosity if pavarotti lived here he would just be a minor curiosity and probably because he was fat more than because he sang jean dielsi remembers finding work in 1943 as a cashier at a diner that would become a south philly landmark it was the only diner around and it was open 24 hours if you went to dances everybody would go to the melrose diner afterwards no there was no mel or rose it was named after a can of tomatoes in addition to being philadelphia s first neighborhood south philly is the oldest ethnically and racially mixed big city neighborhood in the nation catherine williams remembers growing up black on hoffman street we had everything we had the jews we had italians we had the blacks we even had a portuguese family you never knew there was a color thing back then i was the only black in my class at southwark but you never knew in the third fourth grade some of those italian boys was big but you would have thought they were brothers to me these are some of the people and the opinions that make up south philadelphia and murray dubin will take you on a resident s tour of the ultimate city neighborhood but for every interview there s also a lot of history and dubin provides an historical examination that spans 300 years from thomas jefferson living in south philadelphia in 1793 to

italians throughout philadelphia developed their own little italy communities to the north west and farther south of the original boundaries

larry kane dean of philadelphia news anchors arrived in town to take a job as a radio broadcaster on september 12 1966 driving across the walt whitman bridge he spotted several fires raging to the south after paying his toll he drove to a pay phone and called the fire emergency line the dispatcher responded whateryoutawkin about them there s oil refineries thirty four years later larry knows all about the oil refineries in fact there s very little that goes on in philadelphia that he hasn t reported on at one time or another and it s all here in this easy reading look at philadelphia government and politics and the trials of a journalist trying to cover them for larry kane watchers this book answers some nagging questions why did he leave for new york and why did he come back what s the story behind the bill green lawsuit does he apply his own makeup larry is candid about his own mistakes and about his successes he talks about his insecurities and the strain of living life in the spotlight but this is first and foremost a book about philadelphia by a man who knows the city intimately he has been close to more philadelphia power figures than perhaps any other person here he talks personally about ed rendell arlen specter vince fumo lynne abraham john cardinal krol leon sullivan and of course the legendary frank rizzo he has visited jimmy tayoun in jail co hosted a weekend radio marathon with john lennon and interviewed shirtless lenny dykstra who insisted that the news team could just clip the microphone to his chest hair larry also has tales to tell about watching martin luther king jr s killer being apprehended in heathrow airport about barely escaping the riot at the 1968 chicago democratic convention about traveling to earthquake stricken italy and to dissent torn israel he has even been to alaska to see the pope yes he s also met him more conventionally at the vatican these are the reminiscences of a master storyteller a man whose job has been to see the city accurately and report on it informatively whether you re more familiar with richardson dilworth or boyz ii men you will laugh groan and be moved by larry kane s view of philadelphia
