whether we re buying a pair of jeans ordering a cup of coffee selecting a long distance carrier applying to college choosing a doctor or setting up a 401 k everyday decisions both big and small have become increasingly complex due to the overwhelming abundance of choice with which we are presented as americans we assume that more choice means better options and greater satisfaction but beware of excessive choice choice overload can make you question the decisions you make before you even make them it can set you up for unrealistically high expectations and it can make you blame yourself for any and all failures in the long run this can lead to decision making paralysis anxiety and perpetual stress and in a culture that tells us that there is no excuse for falling short of perfection when your options are limitless too much choice can lead to clinical depression in the paradox of choice barry schwartz explains at what point choice the hallmark of individual freedom and self determination that we so cherish becomes detrimental to our psychological and emotional well being in accessible engaging and anecdotal prose schwartz shows how the dramatic explosion in choice from the mundane to the profound challenges of balancing career family and individual needs has paradoxically become a problem instead of a solution schwartz also shows how our obsession with choice encourages us to seek that which makes us feel worse by synthesizing current research in the social sciences schwartz makes the counter intuitive case that eliminating choices can greatly reduce the stress anxiety and busyness of our lives he offers eleven practical steps on how to limit choices to a manageable number have the discipline to focus on those that are important and ignore the rest and ultimately derive greater satisfaction from the choices you have to make

mobile and wireless communications applications have a clear impact on improving the humanity wellbeing from cell phones to wireless internet to home and office devices most of the applications are converted from wired into wireless communication smart and advanced wireless communication environments represent the future technology and evolutionary development step in homes hospitals industrial vehicular and transportation systems a very appealing research area in these environments has been the wireless ad hoc sensor and mesh networks these networks rely on ultra low powered processing nodes that sense surrounding environment temperature pressure humidity motion or chemical hazards etc moreover the radio frequency of transceiver nodes of such networks require the design of transmitter and receiver equipped with high performance building blocks including antennas power and low noise amplifiers mixers and voltage controlled oscillators nowadays the researchers are facing several challenges to design such building blocks while complying with ultra low power consumption small area and high performance constraints cmos technology represents an excellent candidate to facilitate the integration of the whole transceiver on a single chip however several challenges have to be tackled while designing and using nanoscale cmos technologies and require innovative idea from researchers and circuits designers while major researchers and applications have been focusing on rf wireless communication patient wireless communication based system has started to draw some attention from researchers for a terrestrial system as well as for aerial and satellite terminals this renewed interested in optical wireless communications is driven by several advantages such as no licensing requirements policy no rf radiation hazards and no need to dig up roads besides its large bandwidth and low power consumption this second part of the book mobile and wireless communications systems we hope that this book will be useful for students researchers

the tale begins over three hundred years ago when the fair people the goblins fairies dragons and other fabled and fantastic creatures of a dozen lands fled the old world for the new seeking haven from the ways of man with them came their precious jewels diamonds rubies emeralds pearls but then the fair people vanished taking with them their twelve fabulous treasures and they remained hidden until now across north america these twelve treasures over ten thousand dollars in precious jewels are buried the key to finding each can be found within the twelve full color paintings and verses of the secret yet the secret is much more than that at long last you can learn not only the whereabouts of the fair people s treasure but also the modern forms and hiding places of their descendants the toll trolls maitre d eamons elf alphas tupperwerewolves freudian sylphs culture vultures west ghosts and other delightful creatures in the world around us the secret is a field guide to them all many armchair treasure hunt books have been published over the years most notably masquerade 1979 by british artist kit williams masquerade promised a jewel encrusted golden hare to the first person to unravel the riddle that williams cleverly hid in his art in 1982 while everyone in britain was still madly digging up hedgerows and pastures in search of the golden hare the secret a treasure hunt was published in america the previous year author and publisher byron preiss had traveled to 12 locations in the continental u s and possibly canada to secretly bury a dozen ceramic casques each casque contained a small key that could be redeemed for one of 12 jewels preiss kept in a safe deposit box in new york the key to finding the casques was to match one of 12 paintings to one of 12 poetic verses solve the resulting riddle and start digging since 1982 only two of the 12 casques have been recovered the first was located in grant park chicago in 1984 by a group of students the second was unearthed in 2004 in cleveland by two members of the quest4
