

## Shalom/Peace

Year 4 Fall Quarter

**Thematic Introduction:** The aspect of peace in the Mennonite church has been an important theological distinctive throughout our history. However, it is often difficult for youth to understand the bible's apparent lack of peacemaking in the Old Testament in contrast to Jesus' teachings in the gospels. The concept of Shalom, the Hebrew word most often translated as "peace," basically means wholeness -- a state of harmony among God, humanity and all of creation. Sharing this perspective as God's initial and ongoing design for all things can help open up deeper understanding and dialogue around this topic.



#### Format:

A 4 week unit on the foundational overview of Shalom; a four-part holistic approach to peace outlined in scripture. Followed by a 5 week unit providing practical application of peace and shalom to students in everyday life.
